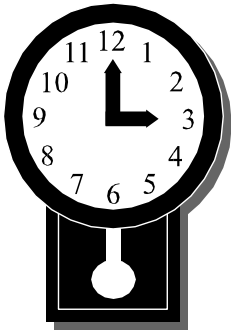

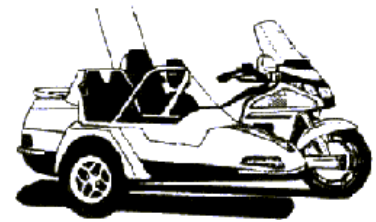

Led by Jim Garner, the group arrived safely in Madison around 8:15 AM. The ride departed promptly at 9:30 and wound its way without incident over 46 miles of some of the best scenic roads the area has to offer. Kudos to the route planners.

After the ride, we enjoyed a light lunch provided by Culver's and attended the Celebration of Life program featuring the Ride for Kids "stars". The 2008 ride had a goal of \$90,000. When the final tally was announced, the goal was exceeded by a considerable amount; the final total being in excess of \$102,000.

## GROOVIN' ON A SUNNY AFTERNOON

Sunday, August 17th was about as perfect a day for motorcycle riding as it gets. Taking advantage of the weather, 18 Chapter H members / guests met at McDonald's for the weekly breakfast & ride. Due to the number of bikes (17), we split into two groups; Jim Garner leading one group & "Lucky Lester" leading the second. We departed shortly after 9, and after a leisurely one-hour ride, met at Mama Rini's restaurant in Crystal Lake for breakfast.

Rumor had it that Jim Garner felt like riding after breakfast, so we all checked to make sure we had our passports in case we wound up North of the border! Eight members / guests took off after breakfast for points unknown, led by Jim. We slowly wound our way Northwest into the Monroe, WI area & stopped at Brodhead, WI for gas, where the days "real" excitement started. One of our members accidentally topped off their bike with diesel fuel, instead of gas..... We left the gas station thinking all was well for a few miles, until the bike used up the straight gas out of the carburetor float bowls & began ingesting the diesel/gas cocktail. The bike sputtered to a stop on the shoulder of WI Route 11. Roadside triage by several

Chapter H members resulted in the correct diagnosis of the problem (actually, we looked at the gas receipt which confirmed our suspicions - :0). Fortunately, the bike was "only" topped off with about 2 gallons of diesel, so the resulting mix still allowed the bike to "sorta run". Anyway, we were able to limp back to the gas station, where the Chapter H crew was able to perform an "emergency transfusion" of the bike's fuel system. After filling the bike up with fresh gas & about 10 miles of blue smoke - all was well.

Due to the time spent on the bike in "ER", and some nasty looking weather coming in from the North, Jim grudgingly decided to cancel the plans to head into the Madison area & pointed our group West. The next two hours or so were spent riding on some really great, hilly, curvy roads - only in Wisconsin... One of the roads was so good, Jim took us in a circle route to ride it again in the opposite direction. Mother Nature's roller coaster at its best.

Next, Cary's sweet tooth kicked in & he was craving ice cream. Jim steered the group Southeast. While cruising through beautiful downtown Lena, IL, "Eagle Eye Eddie Bowser" spotted a sign advertising the sweet stuff. After parking, we looked around & all we saw was an antique shop - not an ice cream parlor. 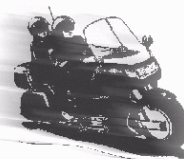

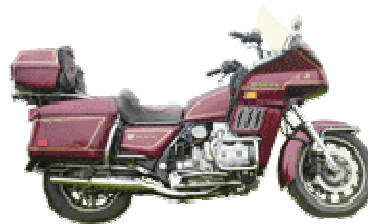
