IS YOUR RIDE READY FOR SPRING?

Okay, pretty much by now, all of us a chomping at the bit to get out for that first long breakfast ride of the year. However, you may be ready, but is your ride? Here are just a few quick reminders of things we often don't think about and you may want to attend to before you hit the open road:

- Tire Pressure and Wear-Of course you want to make certain you are at the bike manufacturers recommended PSI and tread depth
- Oil Change-Yeah, maybe you did it last fall, but viscosity breaks down with time as well.
- Battery Water Level-Hot or cold, water still evaporates
- Air Filter-When was the last time you changed or cleaned it?

- Coolant Replacement-A flush and fill it a lot cheaper than a radiator or water pump replacement
- Final Drive Oil-If you don't know what that is, you are probably due for a drain and fill.
- Brake Pad Wear-A good time to inspect the thickness. Don't wait until it sounds like there due.
- Brake Reservoir Fluid Replacement-This too will break down over time. It's very easy and economical to bleed and replace.
- Clutch Reservoir Fluid Replacement-This is also easy to get at. Have you had yours bled and replaced?
- Fork Oil Replacement-This is something we don't often think of. It's not too difficult to replace.

• Don't forget that the rear wheel splines and front wheel bearings also need to be greased every now and again. With longer wearing tires on the market, the greasing mileage interval is often exceeded by actual wear on the tire. Dried out splines are expensive to replace.

I make no warranties with my advice here. I am not a mechanic and don't play one in newsletters. These are simply a few good reminders of keeping your machine up to par; for your sake and that of those who are riding with you. Consult you owners or shop service manual for the correct maintenance items and intervals. I'm sure there's plenty I missed! Compare dealers and ask what fluids they change with their maintenance package specials. Make sure they replace and don't just inspect the fluid levels. Safe Riding!
